## **Paton Multipurpose Fertiliser**

Paton Multipurpose Fertiliser is a general purpose fertiliser formulated to provide a balanced range of nutrients. It contains all the major plant nutrients and also contains calcium, an important secondary element.

Paton Multipurpose Fertiliser is suitable for vegetables and fruits but can also be used for general application to lawns, shrubs and flowers. Multipurpose Fertiliser promotes vigorous and healthy growth in most plants.

#### **Important Notes**

- Always water fertiliser in well after application. Watering should result in a thorough saturation of the area.
- Avoid direct contact with plant roots.
- Even, light and regular applications of this product will achieve the best results.
- Always reseal bags after use.

**Product Analysis** 

- Sandy soils will require lower rates of fertiliser but more frequent applications.
- Do not exceed the recommended application rates.

### **Directions for application**

Apply to the drip zone of the plant and lightly work into the soil surface or cover with a good organic mulch. Be careful not to damage fine shallow surface roots as this may render them prone to fungal attack and fertiliser burn.

Vegetables	50g per m <sup>2</sup>	Prior to planting, dig into the top 10cm (4 inches) of soil.
	Every 4 weeks after establishment, water in well.	
Flowers and bulbs	50g per m <sup>2</sup>	Prior to planting, dig into the top 10cm (4 inches) of soil.
	25g per m <sup>2</sup>	When flowers produce buds, work into the soil surface or mulch over with a good organic mulch.
Shrubs and trees	50g per m <sup>2</sup>	Prior to planting, apply to within and around the planting hole, working well into the soil.
	100g per tree	Side dress 5cm away from trunk, spreading under the drip zone. Apply in spring and early autumn.
Lawns	50g per m <sup>2</sup>	Prior to sowing, dig into the top 10cm (4 inches) of soil. Top dress with Paton's No. 17 Lawn Food every 8 weeks.
