# **HOW TO APPLY:**

Prior to seeding or laying turf, broadcast the required amount of fertiliser onto the soil surface and rake into the soil to a depth of approx 5cm (2 inches) and water in well. On established lawn areas, broadcast evenly over the area at the desired rate and water in well.

# **APPLICATION HINTS:**

Patches can appear if an even spreading of the product is not successfully achieved. If hand broadcasting, mixing the fertiliser with a carrier such as sand or soil before spreading can achieve a more even result. Alternatively, apply less fertiliser but go over the area at least twice in different directions (one at a right angle to the other).

## IMPORTANT THINGS TO REMEMBER:

- Always water fertiliser well immediately after application. Watering should result in a thorough saturation of the area
- Avoid direct contact with plant roots, seeds etc
- Even, light and regular applications of this quality product will achieve the best results
- Always reseal bags after use and dispose of empty containers properly
- Sandy soils will require lower rates of fertiliser but more frequent applications
- Do not exceed the recommended application rates as this can be harmful to plants.





### SUITABLE FOR:

Paton's No 17 is suitable for warm season lawn grasses such as Couch, Kikuyu, Buffalo as well as cool season species like Tall Fescue, Ryegrass, Bluegrass or mixtures of these. No 17 can be used prior to sowing or laying turf and is highly suited to the regular maintenance of lawns.

#### HOW MUCH DO YOU NEED:

**NEW LAWNS:** It is advisable to apply approx 50 grams per square metre of No 17 prior to sowing seed, planting runners or laying turf. Newly established lawns will need a follow up feed about 6-8 weeks after the initial one. This application should be about half the first (approx 25 grams per square metre).

ESTABLISHED LAWNS: For best results, established lawns should be fertilised regularly, this will ensure that grass remains healthy and robust, and better able to cope with the stress from pests and disease. Regular feeding will also assist root growth, increasing drought and cold tolerance and enabling the plant to recover more quickly from periodic setbacks. We recommend feeding at least three times each year with an application of 50 grams per square metre in early Spring and Autumn and another, of approx 30 grams per square metre, in early Summer.
