DIRECTIONS FOR APPLICATION (Refer to product label for more detailed instructions)

RESTRAINTS:

- DO NOT mow for at least 3 days before or after spray application.
- DO NOT fertilize for at least 10 days before or after application.
- DO NOT apply if rain is expected within 4 hours.
- DO NOT apply to damaged or stressed turf.
- DO NOT cover spray Buffalo or Kikuyu Lawns - spot spray only.

Bent and Fescue Lawns	Catsear, Chickweed, Clovers	Spray 85ml in 2L of water per 10m ²	Mix 45ml in 1L of water	
Buffalo and Kikuyu Lawns	Cotula, Cudweed Dandelion Duckweed Fleabane Lamb's Tongue Mouse-Eared Chickweed Mullumbimby Couch Nutgrass, Paspalum Scarlet Pimpernel Summergrass Water Couch White Clover	DO NOT COVER SPRAY BUFFALO OR KIKUYU LAWNS	Mix 45ml in 1L of water
