Fence posts and palings	Subterranean termites including <i>Coptotermes</i> sp. – in all States south of Tropic of Capricorn except Tasmania	200 mL in 10 L Creosote or 500 mL in 10 L process oil	Excavate 30 cm around pole to a depth of 30 – 40 cm. Apply 5 L of mixture to the pole and the base of the tracks. Apply the remaining 5 L to the soil backfilled into the trench. NOTE: For existing poles and posts, it is impractical to treat the full depth and underneath of such poles and posts and termite damage can occur below the treated area.
Household situations	Ants, cockroaches, fleas, flies, mosquitoes, spiders, silverfish, bedbugs and carpet pests	25 mL in 1 L of light oil or water.	All dilutions should be applied to the point of run-off, except for mattresses and carpets, using 5 L of prepared spray per 100 to 150 m ² , depending on the porosity of the sprayed material. Porous surfaces such as brick, cement, ceramic (unglazed), etc, absorb the spray, and hence more spray is needed to deliver the required surface deposit. Spray in cracks, crevices and other insect harbourages. When applying to mattresses and carpet apply an even thorough coverage. Product may discolour walls, e.g. white gyprock walls. It is recommended to do a spot test before making a broad application.
Lawns	Lawn armyworm (<i>Spodoptera mauritis</i>) Qld, NSW only	5 mL – 10 mL/5 L water / 100m ²	Apply at first sign of damage and as and when required. Ensure thorough even coverage.

General instructions	<p>WHERE TO APPLY:</p> <p>Ants: nests, runs, walls, drains and resting places where ants are seen.</p> <p>Bedbugs: cracks and crevices in adjacent walls, bed frames, mattresses.</p> <p>Carpet pests: infested area of carpet, particularly around edges and under furniture.</p> <p>Cockroaches: walls, cupboards, skirting boards, behind sinks, stoves and pipes. Pay particular attention to cracks and crevices.</p> <p>Fleas: skirting, floors and carpets, kennels, bedding and adjacent wall areas.</p> <p>Spiders: exposed surfaces where spiders are seen, nests and known hiding places.</p> <p>Silverfish: walls, cupboards, cracks and crevices, ceiling and exposed floor spaces.</p> <p>Houseflies & Mosquitoes: all exposed surfaces where these flying insects may rest, e.g. walls, ceilings, verandahs, etc.</p> <p>HOW TO PREPARE:</p> <p>Add the required amount of product to the water in the spray tank and mix well.</p>
Precautions	<p>CAUTION</p> <p>Use only as a surface spray. DO NOT spray into air. DO NOT spray directly on humans, pets, exposed food, food preparation areas or food utensils. Before use remove or cover all foodstuffs, food utensils and places where food is prepared or stored. DO NOT allow treated timber to come into contact with foodstuffs, e.g. in packaging cases or places where food is prepared or stored. Dangerous to fish and other aquatic organisms. Remove or cover fish tanks before use. DO NOT allow chemical containers, spray or unused solution to get into drains, sewers, ponds or streams.</p>
Storage & disposal	<p>STORAGE AND DISPOSAL</p> <p>Store in the original container in a cool, dry place – out of reach of children.</p> <p>DO NOT store in direct sunlight. Dispose of empty by wrapping in paper, placing in plastic bag and putting in garbage.</p>
Safety Directions	<p>SAFETY DIRECTIONS</p> <p>Will damage the eyes. Will irritate the nose, throat and skin. Avoid contact with the eyes and skin. DO NOT inhale vapour.
