Fruit trees	Foliar	200-800g/100L	Apply in sufficient water to wet foliage. Apply in early crop life.
Vegetable crops		200-400g/100L	
Fruit trees	Soil	25-50kg/ha	Apply when deficiency symptoms are first noticed.
Vegetables		10-15kg/ha	Incorporate into soil prior to planting.
Turf	Soil	250g/100m ²	Apply at commencement of season.
Ornamentals	Foliar	200g/100L	Apply in sufficient water to wet foliage. Apply in early crop life

Note: Zinc can be toxic when levels become too high. A leaf or soil test should be conducted to determine exact requirements necessary for optimum plant growth.
